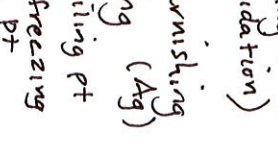
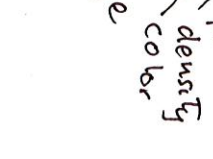
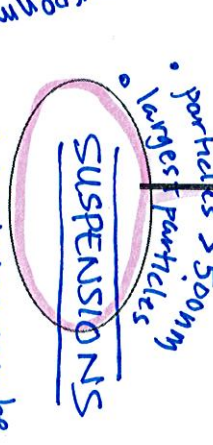
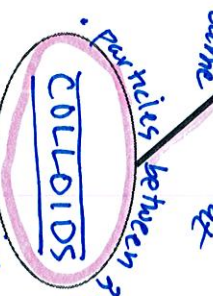
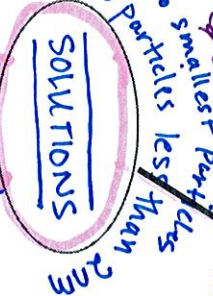
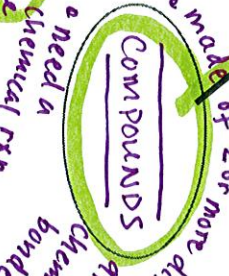
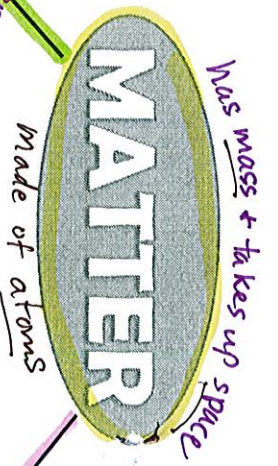


Concept Map
