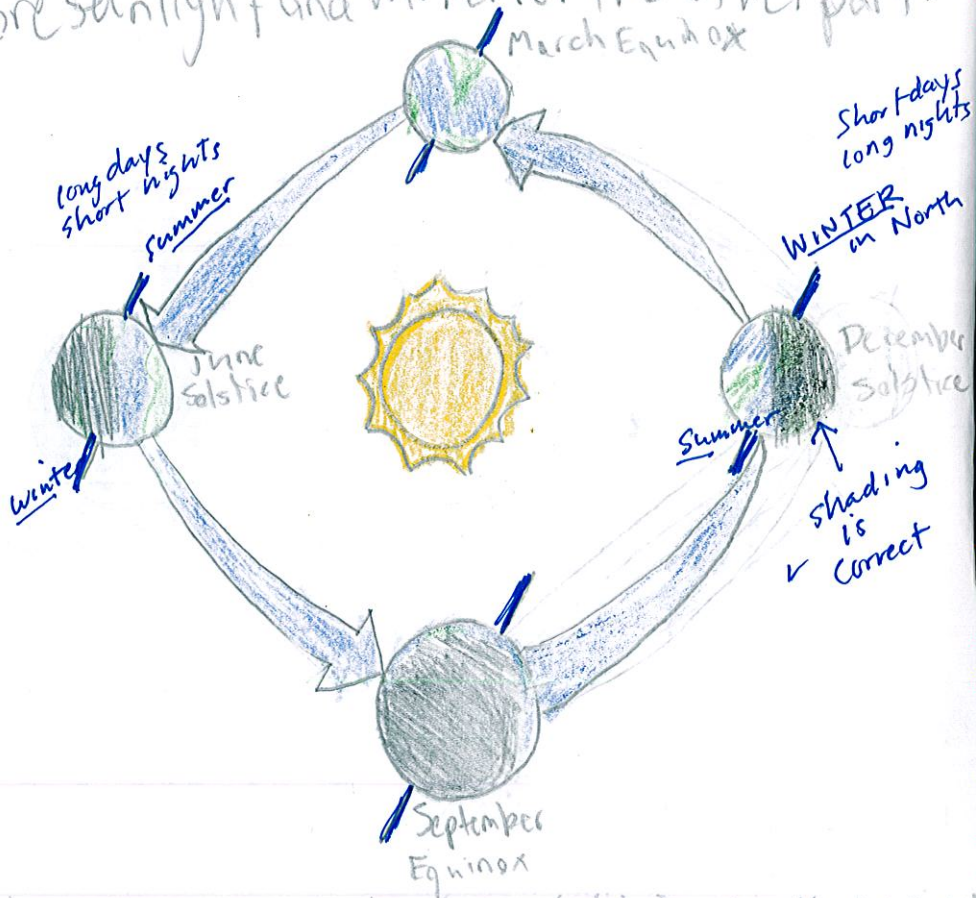


# What causes the Seasons?
